RE ALBOROUGH PLACE AND ALBOROUGH SQUARE.

Dear Sir,

NO. 10. ALBOROUGH PLACE.

We propose to make good slating where defective, grout 2 sides of roofs in valley, solder cracks in lead gutters, fix new R.W. pipe and hopper.

NOS. 11, 12 & 13 ALBOROUGH PLACE

Strip cheeks of dormer, cement fillet four chimneys and gables, make good joints of eave gutters and give same proper fall.

NO. 14 ALBOROUGH PLACE.

Fix 2 lengths half round gutter and $3\frac{1}{2}$ " toe.

NO. 16 ALBOROUGH PLACE.

Fix 5 lengths half round gutter with stop ends.

NOS. 17, 18, 19 & 20 ALBOROUGH SQUARE.

Strip round cheeks of dormer and properly flash and reslate. Repair all slate flashing to 5 chimneys and cement fillet same. Strip slating where defective, take down short length of O.G. gutter at front of No. 20 and fix stopend. Fix 4 lengths 5" half round gutter at rere of No. 17. Fix 3 flue liners and cope chimney.

NO. 22 ALBOROUGH SQUARE.

Fix 10 lengths 5" half round gutter and paint all new gutters. Fix one 2'6 chimney can and cope top of chimney.
