I have been sorely disappointed by delay in settlement of my claim. Creditors have been clamouring for payment of their A/cs; and as I was given to understand when I called at your office some weeks ago that my claim would be settled in about a fortnight from then - I so advised my most pressing creditors.

Now I am again being dummed and on inquiry at the Castle today whether I was referred from your office I was told that it will be another fortnight at least before I can receive cheque.

Is it beyond your power to give me a definite date for settlement? and in the interim to let me have some official note that I can show to my bankers, which would enable me to get an



advance to settle the most persistent demands. I honestly  
believed, when I received the assurance at your office that  
cheque would come some in about a fortnight, that that  
was definite and that there would be no hitch or  
delay. You can understand that my case is particularly  
urgent having during the trouble lost home & business place -  
and was thus called upon to find every item at such  
short notice. I await your reply with anxiety as I  
am in a very awkward position and trust you will  
give me some immediate aid; and expedite settlement  
of my claim as much as lies in your power so  
to do.
