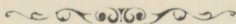

As requested by your postcard of the 9th instant, we have pleasure in enclosing you a copy of the invoice for your 1½ ton Leyland van delivered in May 1914.

We have not manufactured any machines of this type since the outbreak of war, and this class of lighter capacity vehicle will probably not be made after the war, as it is more than probable that the smallest type of machine we shall make will be 30 HP. 2½ tons, the price of which complete with van body similar to your last machine would be £725.

If we were continuing the supply of the lighter type of vehicle of one ton less capacity, namely, 1½ tons, the price would be advanced by 15%
