

This Claimant was stopped in his motor car (15 h.p. Clement Talbot) a little outside
Dundalk on 24th April 1916, by a party of
Rebels who deliberately damaged beyond repair
the four tyres on the car and the one spare
tyre, taking away the two Rugs in the car.
The tyres destroyed were Dunlop's and cost in
or about the same figure as the replaced tyres
but on by Leavy of Dundalk at a cost of
£33. 4. 3. Allowing for some slight
depreciation in the Dunlop tyres which had not
been used for any length of time I put the
actual damage Claimant suffered at about £30.
The "Liverpool & London & Globe" with which
the motor car is insured denied liability in
this matter.

I am acting for Mr William Ireland of Lisnavin, Orwell Park, Rathgar County Dublin, in a claim for £36: 4: 3 the value of 5 motor tyres, 5 motor tubes, and 2 rugs the property of my client which were wantonly, maliciously and wilfully destroyed on the road leading from Dundalk to Castlebellingham on the lands of Dromiskin County Louth on the 24th April last by the Sinn Fein party. The application came before the County Court Judge at the last Dundalk Quarter sessions and was adjourned at the request of the Solicitor for the County Council. Without prejudice would you please let me have one of the forms of claim mentioned in your advertisment.
