

Interests in the buildings

Claimant has no interest in the building beyond a yearly tenancy. Therefore the Plate Glass Windows are ruled out. The pastel portrait of Lady, by F. Stone, was purchased in Dillon's Auction Rooms some time ago at £6, but has now entirely disappeared, the premises having been entered by the military on 27th April. The Oil Painting of a Lady, by Catterson Smith, can be restored at a cost of 15/-, which would only depreciate the article by about £1. This was purchased at Bennett's for £3. Some of the other items detailed are not traceable, having been used as barricades. I think the total loss is in or about £15.
