I had an interview today in Belfast with Claimant and his Wife, in the office of Daniel Tughan, Solicitor, 10 Donegan Street, and, as the result, consider £21.16/- reasonable compensation.

The claim is slightly exaggerated, and, in one instance (3 Pigeons), I have disallowed £3 for Garden Produce &c. as such Property belonged to the Moyode Estate, and Claimant was not in over-insuring compensation in respect thereof.

do hereby solemnly and sincerely declare that on or about the 29th day of April 1916, from about the hour of 3 o'clock P.M. until about the hour of 9 o'clock A.M. on Monday 1st May 1916, damage was done to the undermentioned Property, namely:—House garden Produce Travelling Box Piano, Bed & other clothes Pictures Photographs and other ornaments

and such damage was occasioned to the best of my belief by \*\* a party of Sinn Féin Rebels taking possession of Magode Castle the property of Lady Ardilaun and of which I was at this time caretaker and in charge of and also of the Militia and Police when retreating
