

I have been directed to forward enclosed A/C for damages amounting to £ 8. 18. 6 done to the furniture of this club during the recent Military occupation of the premises by the 2/4 Leicesters

I would like to explain that the 3 new chairs are to replace 3 chairs which were burned and the remaining items for damage done breakages etc.

They also broke 3. 25 C.P. Osram lamps which will cost 9/- to replace. I will be obliged if you will have these claims brought before the proper authority for payment.

I would also mention that the Troops left without notice and there was no official of the club present to point out this damage to the officer in charge
