Dear Sir,

I presented a claim for £153- 10 on behalf of the above and same was investigated by Mr. R.N. Kennedy and a cheque for £110 sent my client.

Mr. Finigan informs me he called on several occasions to see Mr. Kennedy to ascertain why the sum of £43-10 was deducted and the latter promised to have the papers looked up but on calling again a few days ago at Mr. Kennedy's office he found same closed.

Mr. Finigan says that the sum of £43- 10- was improperly deducted and in addition the item of £30 estimated for window fittings for the premises 42 Capel St. was undersharged and it has actually cost £52 to replace same. Mr. Finigan also omitted to charge for replacing 4 gates for the same premises which he estimates will cost £7.

The damage done was occasioned by the Military who occupied the premises and under all the circumstances I would ask you to have this matter re-opened and my client given an opportunity of substantiating his original claim and also the additional items above referred to,

Will you please bring the matter before your Committee and advise me of their ruling.

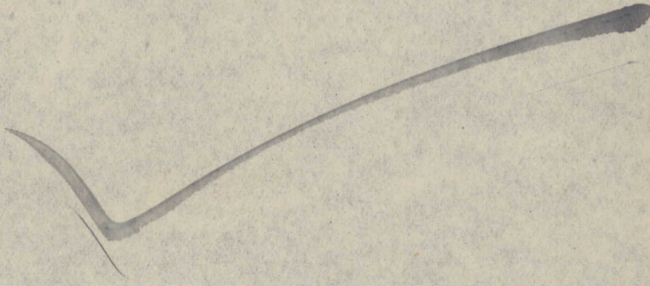
