The attached claim is not understood.

I was detailed to take charge of ten men and occupy a post at Nos 33 & 34, Westmorland St., Dublin, on the evening of the 25th ap. This was done and the party remained there until relieved on the evening of the 29th ap. No necessity arose for either billeting or rationing as arrangements were made to supply the men with food from St. J. Trinity College, also the intermittent spells of duty did not permit the men availing themselves of sleeping accommodation.

I would point out that billeting or rationing was not mentioned.
