Re Claim for personal property lost in Murses Home S.D.U. during recent Insurrection.

Gentlemen,

I beg to bring the following under your notice. After returning to the Nurses Home I found that all my personal property was missing, consisting of the following articles : --

1 pr. gold-rimmed glasses. Silver plated tea service. A Case of Silver spoons Two Silver Salt Cellars. Gold Chain doz. Breakfast Knives 1 China Tea Service. Quantity of Underclothing New. 1 Knitted Sports Coat. 2 Serge Skirts 1 pr. Boots. Also a gold pencil case. Silver thimble. Crochet Work Value 13/-Silk Scarf Value 10/-

The value of above I estimate at £21.

Trusting you will see your way to compensate me for the loss of my property which has happened during the disturbance in the Workhouse from the 24th of April to the 1st of May.
