CORNEILLE, DAVID & COMPANY.

We understand that the Military entered into possession of the premises No. 2, Parliament Row, and that some of the Stock claimed for was distributed by them to the public.

We wrote to the Secretary of the Local Government Board to inquire whether any payment had been or would be made to the Claimants out of the Distress Fund, in respect of the goods distributed. The Local Government Board replied that they were not aware that any goods had been requisitioned from that Firm.

The Claimants Solicitors also communicated with the Military Authorities in regard to the matter, but the Military declined to accept liability.

We beg to advise you that Messrs Gunther and Oxo Limited, of 2 Parliament Row and at 7 Lower Abbey Street, Dublin, have made a claim upon the Government for £ 1012 - 11 - 9 for a quantity of Oxo and Foodstuffs looted or destroyed during the recent Rebellion. We will thank you to inforus if any of the Foodstuffs for which Messrs Gunther and Oxo claim, were given by the Military to destitute people, and if so, whether any payment has been or will be made to Messrs Gunther and Oxo Ltd., out of the Distress Fund.

We may mention that we are acting as Assessors in the matter on behavior the Government.

The favour of an early reply will oblige.

No claim has been made by Messrs Gunther and Oxo, Ltd., against the Government Food Supply Committee for goods supplied to their order.
