
Remarks

The tenant had a repairing lease and was bound to keep the building in repair, but did not do so. The tenant of 180 North King St. was also evicted for non-payment of rent. These premises also were in a bad state before the Rebellion I have gone through each of the houses with Mr. Skelly, the Contractor. All the buildings claimed for are in the same area, which was the scene of much fighting, and the damage was caused by rifle shots.
