

And make this solemn Declaration conscientiously believing the same to be true, and by virtue of the provisions of the Statutory Declarations Act, 1835. Made and subscribed the 30 th las day of Movember 1916, at 1Ensaian in the said City, of Corh before me, a Justice of the Peace for the said City of Cake Daw Horgan J.P.
