I beg to make the following claim on behalf of the Governors of the Masonic Female Orphan School for Coal, Electric Light Use of Telephone, Damage to paling where Military Horses were grazing in paddock and rent paid for house in Merchants Road for pupils who had to be removed from the School to make room for the Military who occupied the school for a fortnight —

 I have been directed by the Committee of the Masonic Female Orphan School to claim billeting allowance for the Soldiers of the Army Medical Corps (Ambulance) billeted at the School during the late rebellion

We have already been paid at the rate of 2d per man per diem for the R. E. and the A. S. C. men amounting respectively to £11-19-10 and £16. 2/-

The men consumed about 10 tons of our Coal which we shall have
