

TERMS NET ON COMPLETION OF WORK.

#### ROOF.

To generally overhaul roof, supplying any missing or cracked slates, any loose slates to be slipped with zinc slips, repoint ridge tiles where necessary, clean out gutters. and solder cracks in same.

#### THREE ROOMS, TOP FLOOR.

To wash, stop, size and whiten all ceilings . Strip, prepare, and hang new paper on walls, supplying paper @ 1/per piece. Pumice, prepare, and paint all woodwork 2 coats Supply and fix new slips to windows where required. SECOND FLOOR, FRONT ROOM.

To wash, stop, size and whiten ceiling. Strip, prepare and hang new paper on walls, supplying paper @ 1/6 per piece, and frieze @ 6d. per yard. Supply and glaze 1 pane of glass. Supply and fix new window elips.

FIRST FLOOR. FRONT ROOM.

Strip present paper from walls, make good plaster where defective. Supply and hang new paper value 2/- per pos.

Piece up the shutter and architrave of window where demaged.

Repaint window 2 coats. Supply and glaze 6 panes of glass.
