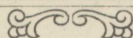

Dear Sirs,

We think it very important, that we should explain for the information of the Property Losses Committee, the difference between the amount insured under our Policies for "stock and utensils in trade", and the actual stock on hand, on the date of the looting.

Up to, and including the year 1914, the average stock held by us, was £1400. It was our custom to revise Insurances each year after our annual stocktaking, and in August 1915, when revising, we covered the amount of stock shown in our books on the 1st April.

When our stock was ascertained in April last, our general manager called on the Agent of the London & Lancashire Insurance Co. (Mr. Sydney Fry) asking for an appointment, for the revision of all our Insurances. It was accordingly arranged for 11 o'clock on the following Tuesday at our office, but Mr. Fry not being able to keep the appointment, came later on, when our Mr. Wilkinson was engaged with another person. It was then agreed, that the matter must remain over until after Easter holidays, but unfortunately the outbreak occurred meantime.

Mr. Sydney Fry has expressed his willingness to bear testimony to these facts, by affidavit, if necessary.
