

I have received instructions from Major E. M. Fortune Brigade-Major of the Black Watch, at present on Active Service in France, to make a claim on his behalf for the loss of his Kit which he left with Messrs William Scott & Co. Tailors, 2, Lower Sackville Street, when he was over here on the Vice Regal I am informed by Messrs Scott that all Major Fortune's property which they were keeping for him, was destroyed during the Rebellion, and they have furnished me with a List of the Articles and the value of same amounting to £54. 11. 6. It is impossible to get the necessary claim signed by Major Fortune at the present time, and I shall be glad to know, in the circumstances if you will allow/claim to be made on Major Fortune's behalf by his Father who is fully acquainted with the matter ?.
