do hereby solemnly and sincerely declare that on or about the 26 day of April  
1916, damage was done to the undermentioned Property, namely:—\* Two oil Paintings  
both hung in Royal Hibernian Academy Lane, Abbey Street Dublin  
and such damage was occasioned to the best of <sup>my</sup> ~~our~~ belief by\*\* Burnings  
of the building (during Irish Rebellion)
