As regards Denis Shaw's case the Committee consider that any evidence as to claimant's complicity with the rebellion can be furnished only by the Police or the Military Authorities.

The reports from both are on the file, and the Committee do not think that the questioning of claimant by them would afford any additional information.

The loss sustained was the result not of military raids on the premises but of looting by the mob.

The sums recommended for payment to Miss E. Farren and Christopher Carren do not cover any property belonging to Stephen Farren.
