Dear Sir,

Claim 3111 Fox.

I am in receipt of your favor of 30th ulto. with papers, which I return herewith

As a result of my conversation with Claimant, Mr Fox, I formed the opinion that £4. would compensate him for his loss in this case. The Typewriter in question was an old model purchased by Mr Fox at second-hand, and, though no price was mentioned, I gathered that the amount paid was substantially that now sought to be recovered from the Treasury.

Mr Fox had the use of the machine for about twelve months, and at the time of its destruction by fire, was negotiating for its sale to the Manager of Wynne's Hotel, Lower Abbey St., Dublin.

Taking all the circumstances of the case into consideration, and in view of the fact that a serviceable, 'second-hand', Old Model, Remington Typewriter, can be purchased for about £4., I consider this sum a fair 'Valuation of full Damage'.
