Sir,

Re - my claim in respect of premises at 1 Henry Place and in answer to your memo dated the 4th Nov, wherein an explanation is required of the delay in lodging my claim & of the discrepancy between the amounts originally & now claimed — I beg to state the following facts.

The reason of delay is that I was unable to get a competent person to make my claim out because I am unable to write myself and find it very difficult to get anyone to write for me.

Re - the discrepancy in the amounts claimed, I beg to state that my first claim was sent in soon after the rebellion when I was greatly upset, and I was unable at the time to think & remind myself

of all the articles that had been destroyed. Several receipts were mislaid on me & the claim was written by an incompetent person. I had occasion (of necessity) to fix up another workshop later on & during the fixing of same I reminded myself of various articles that had been omitted in the first claim. Naturally, when I received the official forms to fill in my claim, I took the opportunity to include everything that I had omitted & I consider the later claim to be a true statement of my losses. I beg further to state that should your committee desire it I will produce all (or nearly all) the receipts of articles set out in the claim. Trusting, Sir, this explanation will be deemed as satisfactory, I beg to remain
