I have your letter of the 24th inst. I am quite at a loss to know what we can do in the matter, saving that we re-instate your Policy.

Our Agent here assures me definitely that he sent the renewal notice to your Firm and also a reminder. I note that your Agent here contradicts this statement.

So far as your Claim against the Government is concerned the fact of your having no Insurance on the goods in question will not affect any payment made by the Government. You are, of course, aware that there is no Claim under the ordinary Fire Policy for such an occurrence as took place in Dublin recently.

I am writing my Head Office to-day and asking them if they are in a position to accept the premium now and make the Policy retrospective. I am extremely sorry that this unfortunate position has arisen, and you can be assured that anything I can do to facilitate you in the matter will be done.
