Dear Sir,

We are obliged by yours of the 12th inst. to which we would have replied earlier but that the writer was out of town. Since our client effected his insurance policies the prices of practically all the commodities stocked by him have increased very considerably, in fact we may say that the smallest increase in any one article is 25%. Matches, of which he was carrying a large stock, nearly £80, were at least trebled in value. The price of a number of tobaccos was also greatly increased not alone by new taxes but by the great difficulty in obtaining supplies. Moreover, our client had shortly before the rebellion made large extra purchases in anticipation of the Budget, a course for which there was no necessity at the time he originally insured, and in consequence he was carrying a stock much larger than ordinary.

The Increase in value of his stock by reason of additional taxation and freights and the difficulty of obtaining supplies was naturally of a gradual nature. Our client was not in a large enough way of business to require the services of an accountant to audit his books or otherwise possibly he would have been advised of the wisdom of having his insurances reviewed. Not having had such services the fact that the value of his stock was gradually outstepping the amount for which he was insured was





We send you herewith claim in duplicate on behalf of Mr. C. G. Henry late of No. 8, Lower Abbey Street, Wholesale Tobacconist, Original Fire policy with Royal Insurance Co. and certificate of premium paid, and particulars and duplicate receipt of policy with the British Law Fire Insurance Co. Our client lost all his books in the fire and we have taken as a basis for his claim the record of his stock taking in January last. At the time of the rebellion like most others in the same trade he was carrying a much larger stock than usual on account of his budget purchases. He was greatly underinsured by reason of this and also of the very heavy increase of prices since the war in practically all the commodities stocked by him.
