Administration to the above named deceased has been granted to his Widow Mrs. Bridget Murphy, and such Grant has been duly noted by Mr. J.J. Healy. the Secretary to the Property Losses Committee. The late Mr. Murphy held the premises in Moore Street under an Indenture of Lease dated the 8th of October 1842, made between William Joseph Kane of the one part and Thomas Agustine Joseph Maguire of the other part for 900 years from the 29th of September 1842 at the yearly rent of £60.
