The particulars of the damage and epairs necessary are as follows:
Top Floor. To refix switch on Landing and renew broken 16 C.P. Osram

Lamp on Landing, also renew broken 32 C.P. Lamp in Bath Room.

Second Floor. To renew four pendants with flexibles, holders, 9" opal shades, and 4 - 50 C.P. Osram Lamps.

First Floor. To renew two broken 50 C.P. Osram Lamps in Fittings opposite windows. To take down your existing Outside Sign, and renew four lead coated sheet iron panels and two doors with the necessary rabbiting.

Afterwards refixing. To renew 12 broken Osram Lamps, repair wiring, and

Ground Floor. Shop Windows. To renew 9 - 16 C.P. broken Osram Lamps and one new switch.

Cellar. To renew broken 5 Amp. Cut-out.

Outside Medallion Signs. To take down these Medallion Signs, make the necessary repairs to the outer cases, repair wiring and holders, and renew eight broken lamps. Afterwards refixing the Signs. To supply and fit behind lettering the necessary ruby glass panels.
