Dear Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 24th instant, I beg to say that the form similar to the one you enclosed. which you stated had been forwarded about 18 months ago was not received here. On the 27nd November, 1916, you were reminded that the claim on the prescribed form had not come to hand, and that unless received by 30th instant the Property Losses Committee would be unable to deal with the case. No reply was received to this communication.

As the Committee sent its final report to the Government nearly six months since, and therefore ceased to exist, it is regretted that nothing can now be done in the matter.
