Name of Claimant Bernard Hanlon Occupation Night watchman Port & Docks Board

Situation of Property 113, Seville Place, Dublin.

I had an interview with the claimant herein. A girl named Costello was killed by rifle fire in this house whilst standing at window. She was laid dead on the bed where she had to be left several days following. Interests in the buildings The blood from the wound destroyed the bedding.

I have discounted the estimate of loss and my valuation would fully cover the damage.
