I apologise for delay

sufficiently awarded for loss  
of Mr. Mc O'Neill's watch.

The fact is I've been very ill  
& away for a long time.

I've been awarded only £15.0.0  
which I got. But the value  
of the watch was about £30.0.0  
The late Mr. O'Neill claimed only

£25.0.0 which he paid to Mr Lyons pawn broker, but he gave his own Gold watch to boot. As well Mr Lyons was a friend & gave him good value.

Under the circumstances I should have got the full claim.

The watch was promised to a brother in law. So I have to supply one similar, which is impossible to get at present.

I tried but could not get the bills as the books were all destroyed in the rebellion. If you doubt my statement

you may enquire the value of a first class Gentlemen's Repeater Gold watch. I hope you will look into this matter. Unfortunately Hopkins & Hopkins books were all destroyed in the fire also. If it was not for that I could claim the full value.
