

with well bound whiting 13 yds a 5/-Strip walls and repaper same 10 pieces paper (P.C. 2/6 per piece)

On outside of building in Red bow Lane fix soot door and frame where broken also fix new ventilator to chimney where broken. the foregoing repairs to chimney
