We regret you are apparently unable to meet our full claim and which as already told your inspector did not cover amount of losses which were incurred arising out of the rebellion in Dublin. Since we sent in our claim many articles have been missed and which at the time of making our claim were not included in the list.

In these circumstances we much regret to see our claim reduced to a payment of £38-10-3.
