## Fallyho Barrack

Abandonment ordered by the  
S.I. on 26 April.

Considered from the nature of  
the structure and the presence  
of about 1000 rebels close  
at hand it would be useless  
to attempt to hold it.

Men ordered elsewhere to  
strengthen other stations.

All arms & records removed  
and as much other property as  
possible.

Two horses & vans sent by  
the S.I. from Loughrea to  
remove the <sup>public</sup> private property  
but, as the roads were held  
by the rebels the vans  
could not reach and  
had to return empty.

On the 27 April the  
rebels broke open the barrack  
and removed all the public  
and private property.

I beg to state that I have gone personally into all the items on attached lists & am satisfied that the claims as set forth represent a reasonable present value. There is an item in each list, which I have marked with a red X, namely "Regulation Book. Hdt Book 1. Kit." that I am unable to ascertain the present value of, as I am not able to find out who the present Contractor for these articles is. I have kept this file back to have inquiries made from Messrs. Ireland & Sons, H. but could not get the desired information.

Kit includes, Valise & Straps, Hdt all complete, Leggings, Blacking, Brushes & Memorandum Book.

The Regulation Books Hdt Books & Kits shown on attached lists have been in use during the total service of each of the men concerned & in the ordinary course, would be still serviceable on the completion of each man's service in the force. In the circumstances, I am of opinion, that the men ought to be allowed a sum sufficient to provide new articles to take the place of those stolen by the Sinn Feiners.
