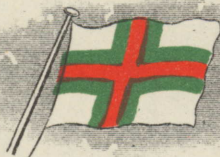

1 C/s. Brushware, "O 2091".




