In reply to your kind inquiry of 20th inst., we bed to enclose a plan showing the measurements as acurately as they could be taken under the conditions.

It would take some time to make plans and take off Pills of Quantities forthe re-building work of Nos. 31 & 32, and we do not know what class of building the Corporation will make you erect, but to put up buildings similar to what have been destroyed would cost, approximately, £5,000:0:0 (Five thousand pounds, sto.)
