I have received from your office a Bank Draft for £18 in payment of above claim, for which I am much obliged.

There is a large difference between this amount & the cost of the watch which my claim was for. I would like to know whether your committee in adjusting the figure have remembered that out of the cost price I have to pay to replace same, a very high percentage (viz a duty of 40%) will

be paid back to the Treasury in duty (probably £6 or £8).

If they have not considered this factor, may I hope that they will make me a further allowance to balance this?

I should say, when asking you to consider this again, I have, since making the claim for £25.19.4, found another jeweller who offers me the same watch for £24.10.0.
