This woman was a cook in the employment of a Publican named Moore at 14, Eden Quay. The building was entirely consumed in the conflagration and she lost her belongings.

Interests in the buildings

Her employer had no specific insurance on the property of his Assistants and servants, but I may mention that in the case of Drapery and other houses where Assistants and servants "live in," and where their belongings are insured, there is almost invariably a clause in the Policy limiting to £10. the amount the amount recoverable on any one Assistant's property in the event of fire. I am of opinion that in this case the sum mentioned amply covers the actual loss.

Payment recommended £10.
