

I have inquired into all the circumstances of this claim. On Easter Monday Miss Kelly's party were returning from Fairyhouse Races, when their car was seized by the rebels on Ashbourne Road, and by the time she received it back was knocked about to such an extent that the cost of making good the damage amounted to the sum above stated. I have seen the Contractor, (W.B. Crawford, Dawson Street) who gave me the fullest particulars and who satisfied me that the claim was quite in order.
