





With further reference to our conversation over the telephone this morning re the increase in price on our goods we desire to say that it would be almost impossible for us to give you the exact amount of increase on each item but we thank that 25% would be a very fair average. Of course a number of our goods have gone up more than this amount for instance Aluminium Paint has increased 100%. All Motor Oils 50% Non-Clog Oil which was formerly 35/- per gross is now 52/10. Standard Carbide which was 42/- per gross is now 57/6 however taking things all round we think that 25% would work out about right.
