Dear Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 23rd instant I beg to state that this claim was not entertained by the Committee because the goods looted were insured under a floating policy with the Sea Insurance Company, who have admitted liability under the terms of their policy.

I am to add that the remittance of 10/- referred to in letter was presumably sent to the Dublin Fire and Property Losses Association, 12/14 College Green, Dublin - an Association formed to protect the interests of owners who suffered loss during the disturbances in Dublin in April-May 1916.

No remittance was of course asked for by the Committee, which was appointed by the Government to deal with claims for loss of property arising out of the rebellion.

With regard to your memo of the 18th instant re claim No. 3898, these goods were despatched from our Works to London Docks, and were eventually shipped by one of the British & Irish Steam Packet Companie's Steamers. It happened to arrive in Dublin when the riots commenced, and we learnt from the British & Trish Company that these goods had been looted, and they advised us to write to the Secretary of the Dublin Fire & Property Losses Association (1916). This we did and received by return of post a blue form, which we were asked to fill up and forward with a remittance of 10/-.

We shall be glad to know why we were required to pay this subscription, if it was not in payment of the insurance premium.

We shall be glad to hear further from you on this matter, as when the goods left here, there was no sign of the rebellion.
