I have inquired into this claim as carefully and exhaustively as it was possible to do. I may say at once that I was by no means favourably impressed by the Claimant. Her son is 16 years of age and I interviewed him also. ~~She~~ The son didn't impress me any more favourably than his mother. She was in the <sup>Interests in the buildings</sup>

domestic service of Mrs. Dunne a Pork butcher at the address stated. The mother stated to me positively that she herself paid in cash the sum of £9. for her son's bicycle the week before the rebellion. She stated the machine was bought from Kelly of Ir. Abbey Street, but unfortunately their books were burned. Nobody in the firm however have any knowledge of the transaction but they could not swear that the purchase was not made. Mrs. Gallagher's circumstances are made fairly clear in the letter to the Committee attached and how she was able to shell out such an amount for a bicycle for such a young lad is a mystery.

I obtained a detailed list of the articles claimed for. In the statement of claim £5. is put down for her son's watch and chain. It is strange that in the supplemental list the value dropped to £1. 5. 0. This speaks for itself.
