All old paint to be burnt off spirit pumiced and filled, to receive three full coats of paint, flatted in nice shade of green and varnished with best copal elastic varnish. All woodwork to be knotted, primed and to receive two extra coats of paint. All lettering and gilded ornamentations to panels, pilasters, facia etc, to be renewed in best gold leaf.
