I beg to acknowledge your favour of 31st March, for which I am obliged. I am sorry I omitted to answer your enquiry as to whether the repairs had been finished. The car has been repaired and tested, and found to run nicely. I hope to send you invoice for the work within the next few days.

If you require a car, I think it will be wiser for you to keep this for the present. There are very few new cars better than it as it stands just now. It is probable that new cars will be purchasable on better terms after the war than now, when nine tenths of the workmen are on munition work.
