Dear Sir,

Lieutenant Quartermaster John Kirkland of the 13th Service Battalion, Northumberland Fusiliers, at present with the British Expeditionary Force, France, instructed us, prior to his departure for the front, to forward his claim in respect of the loss of his furniture and effects, which were in his premises being portion of No.16 Lower Sackville Street. As you are no doubt aware, it is <sup>at present</sup> very difficult to communicate with persons at the Front, and we do not see how we can have one of your forms of claim completed by Lieutenant Kirkland. We have, however, the original information signed by him on the 15th of May for the purpose of making a claim for malicious injury, in respect of his lost property, and also a schedule of his effects which were destroyed, with the values opposite each item, and signed by him, and we shall be glad to know if the members of the Commission will, under the circumstances, be prepared to act on this evidence without requiring an ordinary form of claim to be completed by Lieutenant Kirkland. We enclose original information and schedule of effects.

who makes oath and saith as follows.

That on Friday the 28<sup>th</sup> day of April  
1916 and the three following days Saturday  
Sunday and Monday the 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> days  
of April and 1<sup>st</sup> day of May 1916 respectively  
All that and those the rooms occupied by me  
on the top floor of the house and premises known  
as No 16 Lower Sackville Street in the Parish  
of St. Thomas and City of Dublin which  
contained household furniture, valuable pictures,  
piano, carpets, linoleums, tables, chairs, ornaments,  
beds & bedding, curtains, lamps, mirrors,  
curios, cutlery, china, glass, jewelry, watches  
uniforms, clothing, kitchen utensils, military  
clothing & equipment and various other goods  
chattels articles and effects were violently and  
unlawfully entered and the said contents were  
maliciously burnt and destroyed & demolished  
I say that all the said goods chattels articles  
and effects were mine And I further say  
that I do not know the person or persons or  
any or either of them who committed the  
said injuries or any or either of them. And  
I hereby bind myself to attend and prosecute  
this Information whenever called upon or  
required to do so by the Dublin Metropolitan

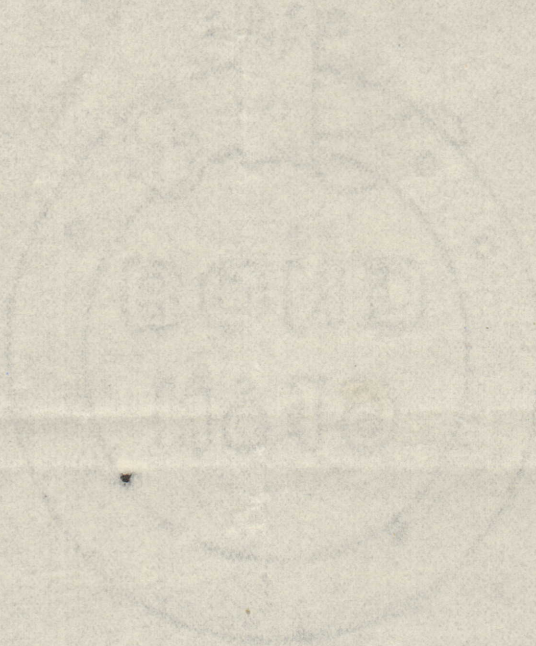
