

Claim No. 3982 Atkins.

I had an interview with the Claimant in this case who lives in a small house in Spencer Street off the South Circular Road, and carries on at that address the business of an Electrical Engineer. He stated that the Candlesticks belonged to his father, and he intended converting them into Electric Lamps. He had a couple of other Candlesticks in the house but they were not of any value. Mr. Kane is a man with forty years' experience of all kinds of silver work, and he states they are not worth more than £3.0.0. I accordingly do not see my way to alter the amount recommended.
