I have carefully inquired into this claim. The Applicant is a Dressmaker or "Ladies' Tailor" and the bulk of the claim seems to be in respect of the clothes of her husband who is a Carpenter. I am doubtful

Interests in the buildings if a man in his position had the wardrobe of the value of his wife's estimate; the latter does not appear to have been able to afford a Fire Insurance Policy, and presumably she is the main support of the household. I cannot accept the statement that an ordinary pair of blankets belonging to these people was value for £2.5. 0. Even at the present high cost of things the best Blankets would only cost 30/- at the outside. The clothes appear to have been taken by rebels for the purpose of aiding them to escape from the College of Surgeons disguised.

Payment recommended £15.19.6.
