I have inquired into this matter very carefully and as a result I am not favourably impressed with the veracity of the Claimant, who is the widow of a Fitter. She lived in rooms at the top of the building Interests in the buildings referred to, the upper portion of which was destroyed by fire. Her present means of support appears to be a small allowance from her late husband's Society, added to what she makes through looking after a child or two belonging to other people. I am satisfied that my valuation amply covers her loss.
