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

Share Certificates, Deeds and Documents were on the said 27th day of April 1916 completely destroyed by fire occasioned to the best of my belief by the disturbances which erose in the City of Dublin during Easter Week 1916; that the cost of making a new Will, procuring new Certificates and replacing the destroyed deeds and documents is as shown in each case; that in consequence of the destruction of said documents claim is hereby made for the sums specified in the Schedule hereto; that the claim is made by me as Solicitor for the parties on whose behalf the Will and Share Certificates Deeds and Documents have been or are to be replaced; And I make this Declaration conscientiously believing the same to be true and by virtue of the provisions of the Statutory Declarations Act 1835.
