Guinness, Mahon & Cc., at 16, College Green, who are the Agents for Claimant. I went into the different estimates supplied by Messrs. Lidwell, Builders, for £22. 10. 0., together with a further estimate of repairs by Brennan, £2. 10. 0., and damage to roof £5. Some of the work carried out was not I consider essential, and therefore I could not pass some of the items. After making the necessary deductions I think £25. should compensate.
