Prior to the late Rebellion I purchased 4 lbs. of Tobacco from M.R. Lalor, 4 Westland Row, Dublin for delivery in lots as required at a cost of £1.16.0 as per enclosed receipted a/c dated 4th April last. Before the Rebellion, I had got delivery of 1 lb. leaving 3 lbs. remaining in Mr. Lalor's possession. His Premises were looted, and the 3 lbs. of tobacco awaiting delivery to me were taken along with his other stock. I was under the impression that this item would have been included in his claim, but he informs me that that was not so as the claim should be made in my name. I beg accordingly to lodge form of claim for £1..7..0 below.

Any further particulars required either Mr. Lalor or I will both be glad to furnish them.
