Interests in the buildings

Claimant left the property detailed with Mr. Grandy who was a friend ofher husband. She is the wife of Mr. Patrick MacIntyre, who is at present driving a motor ambulance in France. Mr. MacIntyre was a Stockbroker until about 18 months ago in this City, but became bankrupt, losing some £30,000 of his wife's and his own money. I have gone into the claim very fully with Mrs. MacIntyre. The linen articles were all purchased from Messrs. Pim Bros. some seven years ago, the cost price being £32. 4. 7. and Claimant states these were very little worn. The dressing case was a wedding present and the value is only guessed at. Previous to my interview with Claimant I inquired from Mr. Henry Grandy and showed him the claim. From his knowledge of Claimant he would not doubt its accuracy. However I believe that £23. is about the extent of her loss.
