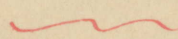

re Peter Branagan, 47, Waterford St: 4/8/16

We are in receipt of your letter of 20th

inst., with reference to ours of the 18th May
and to your reply thereto of the 26th May. As
we informed you in our letter of the 18th May,
our client was detained as a Refugee from the
28th April to the 1st May in the Custom House
and he does not know the name of the Unit which
were carrying out the operations in his Locality.

We may say that if he did he would be only
to happy to inform you of the name of the Unit
but owing to the fact that all the soldiers were
dressed in the same uniform it was impossible for
an ordinary individual to distinguish one Unit
from another.
